- ✚ **Gentle Sportsmanship Reminder: As a school community of avid Savage Warrior basketball supporters and fans, we encourage everyone to follow our PRIDE Sportsmanship Program at home and away games. The purpose of our PRIDE program is to kindly, yet firmly, remind spectators and coaches to do an emotion regulation check should frustrations occur during an event.**
  - ✓ The following clarifying points of the program will help refresh our memories of the PRIDE Program:
  - ✓ A small, orange colored card will be given by administration and/or activities director when the following irregular behaviors occur:
    - Using derogatory language, yelling negative emotional words or phrases, hand signals, throwing items, and/or spitting at officials, students, or others;
    - Displaying impaired behavior due to use of substances that are not permitted on school grounds;
    - Administration and/or activities director have the right to determine and take action on other inappropriate behaviors that are not listed above.
  - ✓ You will find the PRIDE information in each sports program at every event!
  - ✓ This year the Montana High School Association made a change pertaining to technical fouls. The change is that sports officials do not have to give a courtesy technical foul warning.
- ✚ **Calling all interested Savage community members who want to be involved in our school as a board member!!! The election process begins in February and the election is held in May.**
- ✚ **The next School Board meeting is Tuesday, January 19<sup>th</sup>, 2021 at 7:00 PM in the Commons.**
- ✚ **The 67<sup>th</sup> Legislative Session is in full swing and I am watching and listening to the bills that impact schools. Funding education is important to all of us.**
- ✚ **We have received information about the Elementary and Secondary School Emergency Relief Fund (ESSER II). There will be more information to follow as the state unpacks the details of the money. At this time, we have a received a document telling of preliminary amounts for each school district. These amounts vary from school to school. Our tentative amounts are: Elementary \$56,653, High School \$40,900. Funds must be used in accordance to federal regulations and for the purpose of needs to operate a school in these COVID times.**
