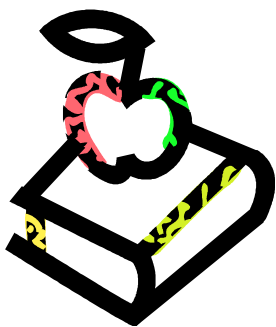

You may take special effort to reach out to those that are in our hearts and minds because of the special memories you share and the hope that more will be created in the future. And we do have so much for which to give thanks. Savage is an area that is not so commonly found in the US anymore. Everyone knows each other's families, homes, dogs, and even when a neighbor's tail light is out. Better yet, we watch out for those that we know are experiencing challenges in their daily lives, and reach out to see how we can help those overcome obstacles or just to let them know we are thinking of them.
